**Sometimes the communities we serve with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ have needs...practical ones....like the school at Baptine.**

I have been working with 4 leaders in this area for almost 2 years now, and have driven past the local school at Baptine on many occasions. I noticed the roof of the school had been blown off and was touched by this.



As I was thinking of what we could do, the Sabiè Game Park personnel asked if there was some way we could help them put a roof back on the school.

Charles Parker, a long time friend and co-worker in the gospel responded by bringing a team from Living Hope Fellowship to help put the roof on.

Pst. Chris Rieber, Elizabeth Estez, Mike Riley (White Sulphur Baptist Church), Charles, and Charles' grandson, Nick came to help. My longtime friend and helper in the gospel, Ishmael Mathebula came to help interpret for the team as Elizabeth ministered to the children and we preached in the evenings. **Many responded to the gospel...both children and adults alike.**



Please pray that they would realize the life commitment they have made and begin to attend church and turn from the things that have bound them in the flesh for so long.

The partnership with Sabiè Game Park, managed under the father/son team of Herb and Mark Bourne and their wives Maureen and Marion is bearing fruit. **The community is being impacted with jobs and vision for future economic growth** as lodges and tented camps are erected, which will bring in foreign income.
