Dear Friends

We're on the brink of yet another Mozambique trip moving into a new village called Mucacaza (Gungwe).

We are slowly working through the area doing evangelism from village to village and our circle of leaders is growing.

We're gearing up for an **inter-denominational conference** in **Shlavani village** in **October**.

We really need your prayers as the leaders were quite daunted at the task of **calling 6-7 congregations together** in one venue and providing for them.

Many, after years of depravation during the war, need to see God's hand move in a tangible way to grow their faith and trust in Him.

So far, this year we have done 3 trips to Mozambique. In

January (10 –15) we were in **Shlavane**, meeting with leaders and doing evening evangelistic meetings. This led to the next meeting in **Sabiè at the Assemblies of God church** at the end of March (**29 March—3rd April**).

Our next trip was from **13—18 June**, also in **Sabiè** and this time the meeting was hosted by the **Alpha Omega Church**.

The meetings went very well although the understanding of the Alpha Omega Church of why we should be there was contrary to why we agreed to come in the first place.
